



**Notification of The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology
On Intention of Administration with Honesty and Anti-Corruption
For Fiscal Year 2024**

As a government agency that values the prevention and suppression of corruption, The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) performs its duties with honesty, transparency, and good governance by following the principles of Corporate Governance and encouraging its executives and personnel to perform their duties with morality. IPST executives and personnel shall not be involved in a conflict of interest and exploit power of their positions for any person's advantage; they stand against any forms of corruption in order to gain trust from all stakeholders of IPST and to promote sustainable corporate development.

IPST hereby notifies its intention to perform the duties with honesty and anti-corruption for fiscal year 2024 to its executives and personnel to adhere with the following principles.

1. **Transparency:** administering with transparency; not concealing or distorting information; providing opportunities for outsiders or stakeholders to participate in IPST's operating processes; taking into account public interest; complying with relevant laws, regulations, orders, and rules
2. **Accountability:** performing duties with enthusiasm and service-minded attitude; having the courage to take responsibility for the results of duties; managing the organization with honesty
3. **Corruption Prevention:** not being involved in any forms of corruption and misconduct and ignoring any actions that are considered corruption or misconduct; cooperating in providing information or investigating facts
4. **Morality and ethics within the organization:** strictly following policies, rules, regulations, guidelines and standards; being committed to successful administration based on the principles of rightness, fairness, morality, ethics and good governance

**Notification of The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology
On No Gift Policy
For Fiscal Year 2024**

The Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128, prohibits any government officials from accepting any properties or benefits, which may be calculated into a monetary value, other than legitimate properties or benefits permitted by laws, rules, or regulations as issued by virtue of law. The exception is made for the acceptance of properties or benefits on an ethical basis with regard to the criteria and amount determined by the National Anti-Corruption Commission. In addition, the cabinet meeting on 8 December 2020 approved the resolution on the national reform plan on the prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition) to carry out important reform activities. The reform activity item 4: “The development of Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and free from benefits” specifies Goal 1.1 as “Every government agency shall declare itself to be an agency where all officials do not accept gifts of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).”

In order to promote preventive measures of corruption and misconduct in the government sector and express the intention of opposing all forms of corruption as well as strengthening the culture and values of honesty, morality and ethics and having no conflicts of interest in performing duties, The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) has therefore set a policy to be an organization in which all personnel do not accept gifts of any kind or any other benefits while, before and after performing duties that may result in corruption and misconduct—at both present and future and on every occasion and every festival. IPST hereby asks personnel at all levels of IPST to express good wishes to each other on various occasions through greeting cards, notebooks for well-wishers, social media, and/or volunteering activities instead of giving gifts and comply with the organic act, cabinet resolution and related regulations in a stringent manner.
