



**Notification of The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology
On Intention for the Promotion of an Organization with Morality and Anti-Corruption
For Fiscal Year 2026**

As a government agency that values the prevention and suppression of corruption, The Institute for the Promotion of Teaching Science and Technology (IPST) performs its duties with honesty, transparency, and good governance by following the principles of Corporate Governance and encouraging its executives and personnel to perform their duties with morality. IPST executives and personnel shall treat one another with respect and dignity, refrain from unfair discrimination, and oppose all forms of corruption in order to gain trust among all stakeholders of IPST and to promote sustainable corporate development.

IPST hereby notifies its intention for the promotion of an organization with morality and anti-corruption for fiscal year 2026 with the following guidelines.

1. IPST executives and personnel shall work together to foster IPST as a moral organization by promoting good conduct that reflects morality and ethics. Mechanisms shall be used to guide actions for maximum benefit and to establish appropriate values for IPST. The five target principles, including sufficiency, discipline, honesty, volunteerism, gratitude, are developed through IPST's "Problems We Want to Solve" and "Good Deeds We Want to Do".
2. IPST shall administer and operate based on equality by creating a positive working environment that promotes mutual respect, dignity, and gender, ethnic, and religious equality. The organization shall ensure equality of opportunity, refrain from unfair discrimination, and prevent any acts of harassment or sexual misconduct in the workplace.
3. IPST executives and personnel shall not engage in conflicts of interest, misuse their authority for personal gain or for the benefit of others, and ignore any acts that indicate corruption or misconduct. They shall cooperate in providing information or in investigating the facts, and oppose all forms of corruption.
